Rodi is an Aerospace Engineer and began his career at NASA's Goddard Center in the U.S., implementing advanced electronic technologies for satellite data intelligence. Transitioning to Race Engineering, he contributed to five Formula 1 championships with Scuderia Ferrari (2000–2005) and played a key role in Red Bull Racing's first podium finish in 2006. Afterward, he focused on business development, holding senior roles at Magneti Marelli and McLaren Group. Today, Rodi serves as CEO and co-founder of the E1 World Championship with Alejandro Agag, the creator of Formula E and Extreme E. E1, the world's first electric powerboat series, aims to revolutionize the entertainment industry and accelerate marine electrification. Rodi remains active as an advisor for tech firms and universities and participates regularly in thought leadership conferences.

Born in Venice, Spiller began DJing at 15, quickly making a name with his debut record *Spiller From Rio*, which topped the US Billboard Dance charts. His 2000 hit *Groovejet (If This Ain't Love)*, featuring Sophie Ellis-Bextor, became a massive international success, claiming top singles chart spots in the UK and beyond, holding the title of the UK's most-played song of the 2000s. Apple's head designer Jonathan Ive chose Groovejet to test the first prototype of the iPod in Cupertino California with Steve Jobs reaction being documented as "Oh my god, this is gonna be so cool". Spiller's style spans genres, with remixes for legends like Gloria Gaynor, Cerrone, Run DMC, Smoke City, Bob Sinclair. Recently signed to Defected, he's now producing events, performing at Glitterbox, and touring globally.
